

Title 6 Chapter 6.04 Animals

Chapter 6.12 - Keeping and Caring for Animals 6.12.010 Owners responsible for care of animals. The owner of an animal is ultimately responsible for the behavior of an animal which belongs to that owner, regardless of whether the animal was in the care, custody or control of another individual.

6.12.020 Removal of animal waste. A. The owner or custodian of any animal shall remove any feces left by said animal on any sidewalk, gutter, street or other public area. B. The owner or custodian of an animal shall also remove any feces left by said animal on any private property for which consent has not been given to allow the leaving of feces. A person is subject to nuisance animal penalties if feces are not promptly removed by the owner or custodian on more than one occasion. C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to a guide dog, hearing dog, or other service dog accompanying any person with a disability, if such animal is actually being used by a disabled person.
