Other Items of Interest

- ** 54 owners have responded to the garage / carport survey. If you have not responded to this survey, Brad will be reaching out to you for your response.
- ** The FHA approval process is underway.
- ** Our "Dumpster Days" were a success again this year, with both dumpsters completely full when they were hauled away at the end of the rental period.
- ** The asphalt project has been completed. There was some delay and an extra day of slurry-coating because some cars were not moved before the asphalt company arrived on the initial work day. One newly-surfaced area was damaged due to someone driving on it too soon.
- ** Striping of the visitor parking and carport stalls has been completed.
- ** Two electrical boxes near the pond were repaired. When a tree up front was removed, the workers who cut the tree in pieces mistakenly cut the wires connecting those boxes.
- ** Bids are still being sought for outdoor railing repairs, a fence repair near the front of the community, painting, and pool repair by CPO (our current pool maintenance provider).
- ** An RV lot audit was performed to determine what and how many vehicles are using the lot, and what size parking areas are being used.
- ** Units 18-19 have a water pressure valve in need of repair. Brad will ask the company which has done previous repairs here to make this repair also.
- ** Mountain Standard Time returns Nov. 6; turn your clocks back 1 hour
- ** Salt Lake County Mayor Jenny Wilson announced her proposed budget will include FREE admission to County rec centers for all children 18 and younger. The Salt Lake County Council must approve this. FRIENDLY REMINDERS
