Approximate Dates to Note in 2024

- Coordinate large sled dumpsters for large-item removal (mattresses, refuse from remodeling, furniture (dismantled), etc).

- Spring, summer, and fall community walk-throughs will continue with Brad and available Board members. Specific contractors will be included when a particular issue needs professional input.

Votes taken by Board

- During the March walk-thru, the Board identified 8 units with failing window tape. A previous board decided to no longer replace failing window tape with HOA funds. The current Board voted to continue this path and require homeowners with failing tape to repair and/or replace windows with their own funds. Brad will be messaging individual units to repair window tape. Here are some contacts for window repair and/or new windows:

- Day & Night Glass this is the company historically used to fix window tape, 801-515-6948
- Window World 801-685-3480 this is the company utilized for the HOA stackable windows and if you refer someone else from our community, you can get a discount
- Advanced Window Products 801-505-9622 if you refer someone else from our community, you can get a discount

Please remember you must receive board approval prior to purchasing/replacing windows to ensure exteriors match in the community.

- The monthly HOA feel increased to \$325/month, effective March 1, 2024. This increase is necessary to refill our liquid assets after some expensive projects in the last couple of years, to replenish and maintain our reserve fund at the required level, and to sufficiently prepare for large maintenance and infrastructure projects coming up in the near future. Additionally, our insurance premium rose significantly.

- Board voted to move funds in our Reserve account to a high-yield savings account with Capital One. This move will help grow our money for capital projects.

** In accordance with the CC&Rs, the Board and Welch Randall are reviewing the current parking assignments. There are still about 33 homeowners that did not complete the parking survey. Welch Randall will be emailing and sending letters to those owners to clarify parking for both garages and carports.

** The Board conducted an RV lot audit in February and found unauthorized vehicles being stored there. The owners of those unauthorized vehicles have until April 2 to claim their vehicle(s) and either pay the Countryside storage fee or move them off the property. Storage fees are \$30/month for a small spot, and \$50/month for a large spot. The RV lot will be monitored regularly. Unauthorized/unpaid vehicles will be tagged with a 2-week warning, then towed if not claimed/paid. The Board will audit the RV lot monthly.

** Spring clean-up started at the end of March and the weekly lawn maintenance will start in April. The Board met with Beehive and is working to update the landscaping/snow removal contract.

** Bids are still being sought for outdoor railing repairs, a fence repair near the front of the community, painting, and pool repair by CPO (our current pool maintenance provider). In the February board meeting Republic (garbage vendor) and Apex (painting & siding vendor) participated through a zoom meeting. The garbage vendor recommended concrete work and a bid request was voted to pursue by the board. Apex will supply color options and references.

** Brad with Welch Randall is working to schedule gutter repair with a new vendor Ace.

** Children 17 and younger are admitted free to Salt Lake County Recreation Centers. Midvale's Copperview Recreation Center is located at 8446 Harrison St., Midvale.
