

The Park Master HOA Pool Rules

Greetings and welcome to The Park HOA. Our goal is for all residents and their accompanied guests to have a positive and enjoyable experience while using the beautiful Park HOA Amenities. To help ensure that all residents and guests have a pleasant experience, we ask you to observe the following rules and information:

- **USE OF THE FACILITY IS AT YOUR OWN RISK**
- **TRESPASSERS WILL BE PROSECUTED**
- Children under **16** years of age **MUST** be supervised by an adult at all times
- All guests must be accompanied by a resident of The Park at all times
- There is a limit of 6 guests per home allowed at the pool at any time.
- Pool Access is from 6 AM to 10 PM daily beginning on the Saturday before Memorial Day and ending the Tuesday after Labor Day each year, weather permitting.
- Food is **NOT** allowed within fenced pool area
- Glass bottles and containers are **NOT** permitted in the swimming pool area at any time
- Children still in diapers must wear swim diapers AND plastic waterproof diaper covers when in the pool.
- Do **NOT** prop open the access gates to the swimming pool area
- Do **NOT** give passage to unknown persons into the swimming pool area
- Disruptive or lewd behavior in the swimming pool or restrooms will result in the suspension or revocation of swimming pool privileges
- Pets are **NOT** permitted in the swimming pool area at any time
- One key will be provided to each lot / homeowner. Additional keys will not be issued, and replacement keys will be charged at \$50.00.
- There are no swim lessons allowed in the community pool.
- Large flotation devices and toys (those exceeding 36 inches in diameter) present a drowning hazard and are **NOT ALLOWED** in the swimming pool.
- Inflatable armbands, water wings, swimmies, floaties, pool noodles, or similar swim aids are permissible so long as they do not exceed the 36 inches in diameter limitation, and are limited to one (1) per person.
- When activated, key fobs provide access to the swimming pool area and into the restroom areas only.
- The Swimming pool may not be reserved for any private event.
- Pickleball Courts: Please be advised that the pickleball courts are a first come first serve basis. This area is not for use of picnics or a gated area to let your pets run free.
- Anyone that violates any of these pool rules are subject to fines and deactivation of amenity use.
- If you see anyone violating these rules, please contact Welch Randall.
- The pool is cleaned daily and the bathrooms cleaned four times per week. However, if you find anything amiss or needing attention, please contact Welch Randall immediately.
- Please notify Welch Randall for violations. Management will respond during normal business hours.
